The program aims to communicate and motivate leaders that safety culture is a collective commitment to safety, that is not focus only on individuals but on the team both onboard and ashore and the organization as a whole.

Safety performance program that is managed from the top and bottom up is a vital element in achieving a solid safety culture. The program will equip leaders to take the lead on safety issues so that they not only discharge their personal obligations, but also improve the safety culture and performance of the organization by increasing their awareness and understanding of the key human factors as well as acquire and develop tools and practical skills to enhance their effective safety leadership accountability and capability.

Everyone must possess a set of right attitude and behaviour demonstrating that safety issues and concerns receive the attention it warranted. Behaviors are the “ingredients” that pulls everything together that lead to a safe job completion.
