SCOPE & PURPOSE

Intro to Shell Partners for Safety aims to share best practice material in order to achieve a step-change in safety performance.

The course will benefit the company as it promotes amongst crew to recognize what it takes to identify and make a change in leadership behaviour, gain a deeper behavioural understanding on learning using the structured reflective learning concept, encourage sharing of experiences and meaningful safety discussions around their learning outcomes, and improve resilience to have a more positive mindset and a wider range of strategies on hand for dealing with everyday problems, both at home and onboard.
