SCOPE & PURPOSE

A government mandated seminar. PDOS serves as a “primer” for OSM seafarers set to work on board vessels and ready to sail in various foreign countries.

Different guidelines and procedures from standardized OWWA PDOS module, OSM company specific topics such as crewing & processing, accounting & finance, and protection & indemnity are discussed.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

At the end of this course, learner will be able to:

- Understand and adhere to guidelines and procedures of both OWWA and OSM on pre-departure
- Identify and explain the benefits of OWWA PDOS to departing OFWs
- Explain crewing policies and procedures
- Explain accounting procedures such as home allotment, master payment order, joining cash advance etc.
- Describe the importance of OSM Extended Family Insurance to OSM seafarers and their beneficiaries
